

ABOUT RAISING THE VILLAGE

Raising The Village is a non-profit organisation dedicated to helping rural communities in Sub-Saharan Africa overcome ultra-poverty.

Raising The Village partners with last-mile farming communities in Sub-Saharan Africa over 24 months, crafting sustainable pathways to prosperity through a multi-dimensional programme model. Impact is measured in the growth of household incomes year-after-year as communities transition from subsistence farming to income generation, breaking the chronic cycle of ultra-poverty.

- Increasing Household Income by increasing agricultural productivity and creating new income-generating opportunities.
- Enabling Participation by addressing barriers such as lack of access to basic necessities, and creating an environment where communities can participate in and take ownership of development activities.
- Ensuring Sustainability by building local capacity and structures to ensure long-term sustainability of their programs, including forming cooperatives and providing financial literacy training.

Raising the Village has been expanding its reach and impact, partnering with communities to improve household incomes and break the cycle of ultra-poverty. Their programmes have shown significant results, such as increased agricultural productivity and income diversification.

Raising The Village aims to increase household incomes from as little as \$0.75/day to over \$2/day within 24 months. They emphasise the inclusion of women, youth, and vulnerable households in their programmes.

In order to support this growth and minimise risks associated with expansion, the Regional Director of Operations will consolidate and optimise various functions (operations, procurement, logistics, health, safety and security) while building cohesive teams and working closely with Raising The Village leadership to deliver cost-effective, high-impact, data-driven and scalable programmes.

The organisation requires a strong leader with at least twelve years of experience leading complex multi-country operations across sub-Saharan Africa. The ideal candidate will have external benchmarking experience having worked with National, Regional and International Stakeholders.
