PowerGen Renewable Energy (PowerGen) is an innovative and dynamic renewable energy company designing, building, and operating the next generation of power generation and distribution projects, or 'power grids,' that provide clean, affordable energy to underserved on-grid and off-grid communities in Africa. It has expertise across the development cycle and sources, designs, builds, and operates power systems using experienced in-house Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) capabilities and well-established relationships with equipment vendors and construction partners. PowerGen also has highly effective customer and operations and maintenance functions to ensure the efficient and reliable operation of systems once built.

Founded in 2011 and headquartered in Kenya, the company operates primarily in Kenya, Nigeria, DRC, and Sierra Leone and has approximately 30,000 residential connections/households that benefit from 24/7 AC power generated from renewable sources. In addition, the business has developed and is building and operating captive power solutions for Commercial & Industrial (C&I) customers - mostly multinationals seeking cost effective, cleaner, and more reliable sources of electricity to power their businesses. Increasingly, PowerGen is also developing more complex off-grid and grid-connected utility scale power solutions combining a mix of renewable technologies including battery storage.

PowerGen's vision is to connect millions of people to clean, reliable, and affordable power for the first time whilst building the clean energy systems of the future in Africa. With over a decade of experience developing, building, and operating complex off-grid systems, PowerGen now has more than 300 installations in operation and a pipeline of over 100 MW. The company is well led and structured for growth having invested heavily in its people, including business development professionals, development engineers and investment associates who ensure appropriate capital is available. It is governed by an impressive Board and is in the final stages of closing a substantial Series C fundraise which will result in several internationally renowned investors joining PowerGen's shareholder community.

As PowerGen closes its financing and takes on larger and more ambitious utility scale projects, it is eager to appoint a seasoned Technical Director to join the Executive Team and lead the engineering and project execution functions. The role requires expertise in solar PV, battery energy storage systems (BESS), and distribution networks, along with strong leadership, project management, and communication skills.
