Thanks to this ongoing success and further investment, Poa plans to scale its Kenyan operations, which will see an increase from the current 12 networks to over 400 networks within the next 3 years.

They now require a Chief Finance Officer who will be critical to reach this objective. The CFO will oversee have oversight for all of the company's financial operations, including accounting, financial reporting, tax, business control and treasury. S/he will be instrumental in shaping a best-in-class finance function for Poa as it scales from single country operations with sub \$10m revenues to multi-country operations with over \$100m of revenue.

S/he will work with the Chief Executive Officer as they continue to raise capital for the business.

DIMENSIONS OF THE ROLE:

The Chief Finance Officer will have the following further responsibilities:

- Take over ownership of monthly, quarterly, annual reporting cycle from the CEO (KPIs, Management accounts, unit economics, comparisons to budget etc.), ensuring accuracy, compliance with financial standards, reporting in timely manner etc
- Take responsibility for all day to day financial operations of the business (treasury, payroll, FX, financial investments, procurement, tax etc.)
- Own annual budgeting / forecasting process
- Refine 2023 budget / model. Ensure budget buy in to budget from management, board, shareholders
- Own the audit process, ensuring effective correct selection of auditors and timely audit completionensure audit completed successfully within time
- Build financial risk management function (revenue assurance, internal audit, financial controls etc.)

- Manage all day to day aspects of shareholder and creditor reporting and management, ensuring compliance with investor consents & covenants
- Provide financial support to the operating divisions of the company (financial planning, business case analysis, performance analysis, supplier management etc.)
- Work with the CEO to develop (prior to the next fund-raising round) the optimal legal and capital structure for the business to support its international expansion
- Prepare to successfully expand the company's financial operations into other countries
- Contribute to strategic planning
- Build and lead the finance team. Ensure talent and capacity to support the company's growth. Identify and hire the right talent, mentor junior employees, performance management and generally shape an effective and efficient finance department
